We broke ground on The Sharon Wilson Cox Early Learning Center in Bethel. Opening next year, we will **fill a great need for childcare** and early childhood education in the Bethel area.

Six families moved into their new homes in January 2024 after months of building with our Self-Help Housing Program, bringing the total number of **houses built** through our program **over the last three decades to 273**.
